Dunedin has a rich and diverse history. It was the gateway to the Central Otago goldfields in the 1860's. Many beautiful and elaborate Edwardian and Victorian buildings were built from the wealth this created and still stand proudly today. Dunedin's railway station is listed as one of the '100 must see' buildings in the world.

The gold rush brought many nationalities to the area. Chinese workers were brought here. This link with Chinese who settled here has been recognised by sister city Shanghai who assisted the city to build an authentic Chinese garden, one of only two in the world built outside of China.

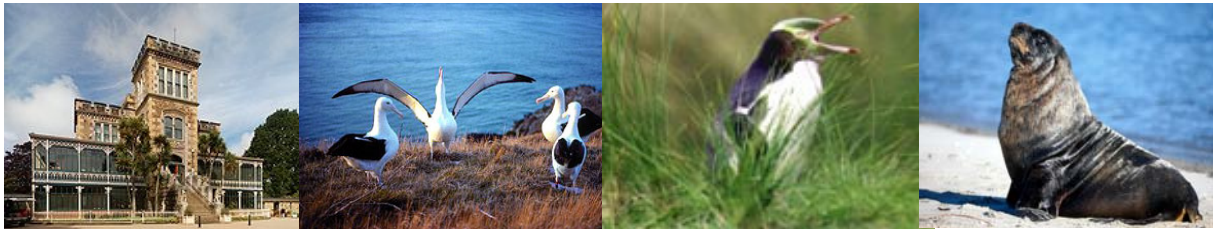
